WHY WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

There are two main reasons we need your support to build this lodge: Leadership and Safety.

LEADERSHIP

Science, Technology, Engineering and Math better known as STEM have become a priority in this country, because too few students are pursuing degrees or training in these fields. In fact, women occupy fewer than 25% of all of the STEM jobs in the country. Girls who are taught a STEM curriculum in a single gender setting have no biases to contend with and this teaching technique fosters curiosity and achievement, all while providing girls with positive role models. STEM is the key to our country's future, and we are helping to lead the way!

The new Moore Lodge will serve as home for Mohawk's STEM programs as well as our Leadership Development Program.

SAFETY

In 1989, one of the state's worst natural disasters struck NW Connecticut – a massive F4 tornado ripped through the area. Lives were lost and the disaster caused over \$125 million in damages. Camp Mohawk was fortunate as no one was injured; but we need to continue preparing for the future.

Moore Lodge is designed to be a top level, severe weather shelter where every camper and staff member can be safely accommodated during a natural disaster. Additionally, it is designed to be fully compliant with American Disability Act requirements.



ABOUT MOORE LODGE

Moore Lodge is a 36' x 48' building, constructed on the east side of camp just past the current Mohican Unit. The Lodge has the capacity for ninety-six campers and staff on both the top and lower level. The top level features a large, gorgeous fireplace and a 12' x 36' deck overlooking Mohawk Pond.

The Lodge has been designed to be both beautiful and functional. Not only will it house programs to develop the leaders of tomorrow, but it will be a much needed rainy-day site and provide a safe, comfortable environment for after sunset activities.

The Lodge is being built under the guidance of top craftsman, ensuring that generations of Mohawk campers will be able to utilize and enjoy this facility for decades to come.
